- Basic Farm Tour- \$6.00 per person*** includes a tour of the farm including the Horse and Cow Barns and an opportunity to visit with the animals of Cracker Box Palace. If you have a large group, we will break into smaller groups of up to 20 people per group. Time allowed to tour the barns and see the animals is approximately 40-60 minutes.
- Tractor Drawn Hayrides- \$4.50 per person***. Kick up your feet and enjoy a ride around the farm on our tractor drawn hayride. You will see our farmland, forested land and the outer edges of the farmstead. Our hayride is approximately 30 minutes.
- Pack a lunch - Free.** We have a picnic area to accommodate up to 40 people in the courtyard overlooking Sodus Bay and the pastures. For any additional seating or special set up, a \$15 set up fee is required. Our picnic area is Carry In/ Carry Out. Picnic area is available to our tour guests, weather permitting.
- Kritter Kris & Feathered Friend's Wildlife Rehabilitation Demonstration- \$4.00 per person***. A live demonstration of raptors and birds of prey and an educational program about rescue and rehabilitation of all kinds of wildlife with Kritter Kris, a NYS registered Wildlife Rehabilitator. All proceeds benefit Kritter Kris & Feathered Friends.
- Guided Nature Walk- \$3.00 per person***. Hike to our red trailhead to enjoy the scenic waterfall and hunt for fossils. The hike to Second Creek is a moderate level walk with various inclines. You are welcome to take fossils home, but remember you must hike back with your treasures! Additional guided hikes available by request.
- Historic Alasa Farm Tour- \$6.00 per person***. Be whisked away as far back as the 1600's in this interactive tour around Cracker Box Palace at historic Alasa Farms. You will learn historical information about the land, the buildings, residents and so much more. Our historic tour guide will also show you around our welcome center located in the Old Alasa Office.

(*The minimum for groups is 9 people or we request a cover fee of \$50 for smaller groups)

Suggestions and guidelines to make your tour safe and enjoyable:

- Dress for the weather. We are located by Great Sodus Bay, so the weather is usually slightly cooler than inland. There is a lot of walking involved, so wear comfortable clothes and enclosed toe shoes. Waterproof shoes are suggested as the grass is usually wet even in the late morning, and if you're planning on visiting the creek it goes without saying!
- Visiting the Animals – Cracker Box Palace is a farm animal rescue and sanctuary; most of our residents have been abused or neglected and are recovering from life circumstances that you can't even imagine. We ask as a courtesy to our animals that no one runs, chases or shouts at them and please, Do NOT feed fingers to the animals, they are vegetarians; keep your hands flat-outstretched when feeding the critters. These are large, live animals with beaks and teeth. Some of their favorite treats are carrots, apples, peppermints, or animal crackers. For safety reasons, visitors are not allowed into the pastures, stalls, or pens. Adult supervision of youth tours is always REQUIRED by visiting organizations. **Children must stay with the supervised group; for safety reasons we cannot allow children to roam freely throughout the farm.**
- There are farm cats who live with us. PLEASE DO NOT PET THE CATS. We caution that they should not be chased or grabbed. They seem friendly, but they are working barn cats who are not as socialized as house cats and may bite or scratch. Cracker Box Palace will not be responsible for anyone disregarding this request.
- Our farm birds may peck at fingers. Please don't try to pet them or pick them up. Cracker Box Palace will not be responsible for anyone disregarding this request.
